## Announces its next Boy Scout Railroading Merit Badge Class

You are allowed to park anywhere in the building complex parking lot. Please enter via the main restaurant entrance. You will head up the stairs, located in the back of the dining room, for class.

The Merit Badge class will begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. Guardians are welcome to purchase meals for themselves, however we ask that no Scout eat during the class. Please bring liquids if so desired for Scouts. Following the class portion you will ride the METRO A Line from the Chinatown Station to the South Pasadena Station in South Pasadena to experience, first-hand, rail safety. Upon completing the A Line ride, you will return to the Chinatown Station and receive the signing of your "blue" card by LARHF's Merit Badge counselors.

Be sure you bring the <u>filled-out</u> "blue card" and writing materials. Class information and preparation videos will be emailed to you once you return this registration form and your \$35.00 fee.

- We ask that all Scouts be driven to the Chinatown Metro Station after the lecture portion of the class at Philippe's. There is street parking available near the China Town Metro Station.
- Scout Guardians are invited to stay at Philippe's during the class, or feel free to leave and come back for the Metro ride.
